Snowsports Leadership Training & Basic Training **Code of Conduct**

- As a student of the “Ski/Snowboard Leadership Training” or “Basic Training” programs, remember that you are in a leadership capacity, and as such, need to set an example for others.

- Be safety conscious and follow safety procedures outlined by Section 8 instructors, guides, and coaches.

- Intoxication from use of alcohol or illegal substances while on program time is strictly prohibited.

- Show respect for the individual - including fellow students, members of the community or employees of Section 8. Refrain from behaviour (including comments, conduct, or gestures) that is insulting, intimidating, humiliating, hurtful, malicious, degrading or otherwise offensive to an individual or group of individuals, or creates an unwelcome environment.

- Bring an attitude of openness, honesty, compassion and humour.

- Bring a learning attitude and approach, including cooperation with instructors and schedules. Inform the program director prior to any absence from the program.

- Show respect for all equipment and personal property of individuals as well as that of Section 8, Mt. Washington Resort, accommodations and other partners. Students will be responsible for any damage incurred to accommodation through intentional action.

- Show respect for the natural environment.
