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Snowsport Leadership Training & Basic Training - Program Registration

This information will be reviewed by the program director. You will be notified of your acceptance and receive an invoice for the program. You will then be required to pay an initial deposit to receive confirmation of enrolment and hold your position on the course.

Prerequisites:

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must be in good physical condition.
- Must have a passion for skiing or snowboarding and the outdoors, have a positive attitude and be willing to learn.

Ski or Snowboard Ability:

-We accept a variety of ability levels on course from intermediate to expert. At minimum you should be at an intermediate level or above, confident and consistent on steeper blue runs (red runs in Europe) and keen to progress. For those who don't feel they are quite at the standard we can offer pre-course training at a reasonable rate.

Snowboard: CASI level 1 exams and membership, CASI Park Instructor level 1 certification, Avalanche Safety Training level 1 & level 2 certification, a Wilderness First-Aid certification, CPR level C, as well as your choice of either the regular CASI level 2 or CASI Park Instructor level 2

12 Week SLT fees also include: 12 Weeks of shared on mountain ski in ski out accommodation, transportation within the program, evening meals Monday - Friday & all meals on scheduled overnight backcountry trips, full seasons pass (including night skiing/riding and X-Country) at Mt.

Washington Alpine Resort, coaching, guiding and training fees in a variety of ski or snowboard disciplines, race module, terrain park module, video analysis, dry-land training and evening workshops, backcountry equipment rentals, safety equipment and group gear rentals, course materials, optional work practicum, some extra-curricular activities and social events, certificate of completion and a snow school job interview for following season. (Bonus surf week includes: an extra week of accommodation in Ucluelet, 5 day surf board and wetsuit rentals and 1day of surfing lessons.)

Washington Alpine Resort, coaching, guiding and training fees in a variety of ski or snowboard disciplines, video analysis, dry-land training and evening workshops, backcountry equipment rentals, safety equipment and group gear, course materials, optional work practicum and certificate of completion.

*Note - Section 8 courses are considered vocational training by the government of Canada so are no longer subject to GST or HST taxes. (Yippee!)

**Note – All payments are in Canadian funds.

Additional Costs:

*Travel medical insurance (mandatory if you are not covered by the Canadian health care system. Please ensure you are covered for off-piste skiing or snowboarding), trip cancellation insurance (recommended), breakfasts, lunches and weekend meals, personal ski/snowboard and camping equipment (see equipment list), some optional extra-curricular activities and weekend trips, transportation to and from Vancouver Island, spending money.

Cancellation & Refund Policy:

-For any cancellations the initial deposit will be forfeit.

-Cancellation up to 60 days prior to the course start date: 100% will be refunded minus initial deposit.

-Cancellation within 60 days of the course start date: 50% of the course fees will be refunded.

-Cancellation within 10 days of course start date: no money will be refunded.
